During the current public health emergency the Isle au Haut Mailboat will operate according to these two objectives:

- We will organize our services to keep our crews and their families safe so that we can continue to serve the island
- We will organize our services to be consistent with the needs of the Isle au Haut community for the safety of permanent residents

Mailboat operations (as of 3/23/2020):

- Beginning on Monday, March 23, every scheduled trip on the Mailboat will be limited to six passengers. We will operate two round trips, leaving Stonington at 7:00 am and 3:30 pm, only on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. There will be no further mid-day trips. There will be no passenger service on Tuesdays, Thursdays or Saturdays. For at least the duration of Maine's declared state of emergency, and for longer if conditions warrant, we will review our schedules weekly.
- Everybody aboard is expected and required to observe the same safe social distancing procedures as would be appropriate ashore
- Reservations for scheduled trips to or from the island are required and must be requested by calling our office at (207) 367-5193 or (207) 367-6516 no more than 24 hours before a given trip.
- Passengers are expected to handle their own belongings and luggage – the crew will not load or unload personal items or handle them on board
- Residents receiving deliveries from off island should not come down to the boat at the Town Landing – the crew will carry deliveries up to the wharf
- Prospective passengers who are aware of having had an exposure to the virus or who feel unwell must let the crew know before departure. We will attempt to find a safe spot for them
